

Please join us in wishing them good luck and safe studies as they embark on a 26 week training regimen. When the Fire Academy training is complete, they will be certified firefighters through the Kentucky Fire Commission. They will be EMTs and will have been trained in basic firefighting skills such as hoses, ladders, fire attack, ventilation, etc. They will have a working knowledge of Hazardous Material operations, auto extrication, and various other types of rescues.

## WINTER HOLIDAY FIRE SAFETY

Did you know?

Nearly half of holiday decoration fires happen because decorations are placed too close to a heat source. It is fun to decorate for the winter holidays, but holiday decorations can increase your risk for a home fire. As you deck the halls this season, be fire smart.

- Inspect holiday lights each year before you put them up. Throw away light strands with frayed or pinched wires.
- Water your Christmas tree every day. A dry tree is dangerous because it can catch fire easily.
- Consider using battery-operated flameless candles, which can look, smell and feel like real candles.
- If you do use lit candles, make sure they are in stable holders and place them where they cannot be knocked down easily.
